"This Year is Going to Be Different!"

Words from your pastor: How many New Year's resolutions have you made in your lifetime? How many of your resolutions have you kept for more than thirty days? Statistics show that over half of Americans will make a New Year's resolution in 2017 but only 8% will achieve their goals despite the proclamation: this year is going to be different. Why don't more Americans keep their promises to change? First, we often make plans to change in the New Year because we're motivated by guilt, frustration, and fatigue which are not good motivators. obey everything I have commanded you". (Matthew 28: 19 - 20)


