## The Resurrection Changes Everything!

Pastor's Corner - No one can deny the fact that the world has changed! We are living in a time of rapidly shifting ideas, values, and worldviews. The Christian church finds itself one again as one-voice-among-many trying to help people define reality (i.e., their ethics and world -view). There is a growing number of persons opposed to Christ's message and others who no longer know the gospel story. Some scholars argue we have returned to the first-century world with it's mix of patriotism (i.e., nationalism) and pluralistic paganism (e.g., anything goes).

Yet, no one can deny the fact that Jesus Christ's life, death and resurrection has changed the world, too! The Gospel of John 20:1-18 tells us, when Mary Magdalene and the other women went to Jesus' grave that first Easter morning, they were frightened because they did not know what had happened to Jesus' body. They ran to get help from the Apostles who quickly came to the tomb. Some were hesitant to enter, others were mortified, and still some stood outside and cried.

The Good News is: God kept His promises! God raised Jesus from the dead. Jesus would appear to the women, to the apostles, and to 500 men and women that first Sunday (1 Cor. 15:6). **Our Church Finances** February 2018 Report

- We are reviewing 16.67 % or two months of our budget year. Our income total is \$55,722.20 or 22.75%. Our two months of expenses total \$44,014.06 or 16.13% of our budget.
- Good news! Our total net income for January and February is \$11,708.14.
- We have \$19,088.78 in our checking account at the end of February. This includes \$4,172.56 in the Youth Fund and \$1,634.03 in the Baby Closet Fund.
- After the congregation decided to purchase a new sign for the west side of the church, the council voted at our March meeting to encourage new/additional gifts through our offerings and then use capital campaign expenditures to make up the difference. Please prayerfully consider helping the church purchase this new sign. Thank you.


