PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE: FACE MASKS REQUIRED IN PUBLIC –The Shawnee County Health Department is **requiring all persons, certain exemptions apply including all children age 10 and under, to wear masks in public, including during worship**, to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID 19) when social distancing (keeping six (6) feet of distance between yourself and others outside your household, except for infrequent or incidental moments of closer proximity) is not possible (see Shawnee County Resolution 2020-44). Masks are on the front pew.
