PAY ATTENTION TO WHAT'S IMPORTANT!

Pastor's Corner - Did you see the Great Conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn's planets on the winter solstice (December 21)? Did anyone else marvel as the "Christmas Star" moved from the East to the West? There was tremendous excitement in our backyard as we peered through the tree to see the astrological event of the year. "Was this the sight the magi



witnessed?" I wondered. "Pay attention!" I shouted. "This will not happen again for another 400 years." A little voice replied in a surprised tone, "I'll most likely be dead." "That's why we're out here," I replied. "It is a once in a lifetime kind of event."

The Bible is full of references to seasons, cycles (new moon festivals), and marvels in the heavens. God's universe reveals His glory (Psalm 19) and serves as a sign of His work in the world. The Bible tells us that stars, the sun, the moon, and the heavenly hosts will foretell of Christ's coming (Joel 2:31, 3:15; Matthew 24:29, Revelation 6:12) so all people - religious and irreligious - will know the Lord is God of all.

Paying attention can be a struggle for persons with ADHD/ADD (Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder). ADHD is a neurological disorder making children and adults prone to being disorganized, forgetful, absent minded, and focused on the wrong things. The readings from Mark's Gospel this year invite us to pay attention to Jesus, the Messiah. He is the Suffering Servant for his people. He offers rescue to every person who will follow him and receive forgiveness in his name. Will you join me on



the journey as we focus on Jesus this New Year?

DOORSTEP - We will start 2021 operating the same way we have been in 2020, with phone intakes for services, and appointments for the clothing room.

At this writing we have not distributed our Christmas items yet, however, Doorstep still adopted the usual 260 households from the Christmas "People Helping People Bureau. This is over 800 individuals who will receive food, gift cards, blankets and health kits. We appreciate everyone who sent monetary



donations to help with the increased budget to provide the gift cards this year; and, those who donated blankets, towels and hygiene items.

There will be no Operation Soup Line this year as the Board could not figure out a Covid safe, fundraising positive, way to carry out the event. We have asked our regular sponsors to still donate the funds and basically 'sponsor Doorstep' instead of the event this year as to not lose quite so much money by not having the fundraiser.

We will still proceed with SouperBowl Sunday, February 7th with the collection of soup and crackers to help stock our pantry! Please collect these items to bring to your congregation, or to Doorstep.

We cannot stress enough how thankful and blessed we feel to be so supported during this difficult time as we continue to help our neighbors in need the best way possible.


