50 DAYS OF CELEBRATING THE EIGHTH DAY

Pastor's Corner - The day of rejoicing will soon be here with its return of festive flowers, beautiful banners, believer's baptisms, and the celebratory chanting of the "alleluia!

Alleluia, Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed!

Alleluia is the Greek and Latin word that translates the Hebrew word, "Halleluiah" which means "praise the Lord!" It is the word the angels use to worship the Lord.

The ancient call and response, and the added Alleluia song, marks the start of the Easter season - the fifty holy days of celebrating from Easter Sunday to Pentecost. We will pass from penitent, solemn season of Lent to the joyful, jubilant time of Easter. It is a time of unrestrained celebration - not because spring has sprung, the long winter has passed, or our return to outdoor living, spring vacations, and gardening. [Sorry, Christians do not celebrate Easter as a pagan fertility festival for the goddess *Eostre*, symbolized by eggs and bunnies, just read the historian, Venerable Bebe.] For followers of Jesus, Easter or *Páscha* in Greek (meaning "Passover") is a time of extraordinary news: Death is dead. Christ has conquered the cross, sin, and the grave. God offers forgiveness of sin by the blood of his son. *Jesus is*



Alive!

Easter Sunday serves as the "eighth day" - the day God anew over with Creation. The new covenant is brought to life by God's powerful act of restoring life to his one and only Son, Jesus. It marks the coming of God's kingdom, and the start of God's relations with the new humanity - a new community - the Church.

The fifty days between Easter and Pentecost is focused largely on the new community: the Church. The first reading of scripture in worship services, traditionally reserved for the Old Testament lesson, is taken from the Book of Acts. Worship focuses on everything new: the new community, the new covenant, the promise of new life, and the hope of a new kingdom on earth, the kingdom of God.



I plan to start a new sermon series during Eastertide: I Love the Church! We will search the stories from the Book of Acts to discover the blessings God has given to us

here on earth: the gift of his Son and Spirit in a community where we can belong. I hope you will be able to join us!

Our Easter celebrations will begin at the Sunrise Service on April 4 at 7:00 am on the patio behind the mansion at Old Prairie Town at Ward Meade Historic Site and Botanical Garden. Our theme will be "Come to the Garden." We will sing, shout Alleluia, hear the good news, light the Christ candle and celebrate. If it is raining, we will have the service in the Sanctuary at West Side Baptist Church.

Our Church Finances

Last month I shared with you that the church had applied for our second Payroll Protection Program (PPP) loan from the federal government. The PPP loan program is designed to provide small businesses including churches encouragement to keep their staff on payroll during the Covid-19 crisis. We applied for \$29,488. Capitol Federal Bank approved our loan and the payment was received on February 26th. Since my last newsletter report we also were notified that our application for forgiveness of our first loan in 2020 of \$23,500 has been forgiven.

Our income for February was \$18,009.34 and our income total this year to date is \$34,663.12. Our budget percentage of income is 16.22%. Our budget year is 16.67%.

Our expenses for February totaled \$17,421.16. Our expense total for the year is \$35,257.42 or 14.46%.

The difference of income to expenses for the year is -\$594.30.


