FOOD PANTRY MILK 2 MY PLATE - The Milk 2 My Plate is a partnership between Harvesters and Hiland Dairy to put fresh dairy product in agencies. Utilizing grant funds from the ABCCR and Food Pantry grant funds and donations, we will tentatively start our Milk 2 My Plate program during the week



of the 19th of July. Our plan is to offer 2 percent milk in conjunction with Baby Closet/Food Pantry hours (Monday 9am - 11am, Wednesday 3:30pm - 6:30pm and Thursday 1pm - 3pm).
