# "WISDOM FOR HARD TIMES"


"If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you." James 1:5

### **OUR CHURCH FINANCES**

The Long Range Planning Committee met again on Saturday, August 14th. A survey from the committee was sent via e-mail to the Congregation asking for any suggestions on repairs, replacements, or new items for our church building and grounds that you would like considered for at least the next 10 years. It was also posted on Facebook and was included in some of the second quarter giving statements. If you have suggestions and haven't submitted them to the

church office yet, please do so as soon as possible. Any items suggested will be added to the list created by the committee members. Once the list is finalized and a cost estimate prepared, we will bring to the Council and then to the Congregation to prioritize for our next capital campaign.

Our income for July was \$15,155.30. Our total income for the year to date is \$148,429.62. Our budget percentage of income through July is 69.46%. Our budget year is 58.3%.

Our expenses for July totals \$15,800.47. Our expenses total for the year is \$139,208.60, which is 57.1% of our budget.

The difference of income to expenses for the year is \$9,221.02. This does not include the \$29,487 from our second Payroll Protection Program (PPP). Good news! We received notice from Capitol Federal Bank that the PPP loan has been forgiven. It will be reflected in next months financials.
