OUR CHURCH FINANCES

The Long-Range Planning Committee met to address the building and property needs of our church on Thursday, September 16, 2021. The committee created a final wish list of the items suggested by the congregation. Thanks to all who chose to submit their survey. The fundraising goal and plans for the launch of the capital campaign to recommend to the council and congregation were decided. After the discussion at the all-church meeting on Sunday, September 12th, Tom Mansfield is talking with Chris Cazier at Modern Masonry about the \$10,000 tower project and what the additional cost would be to rebuild the parapets on the tower. Clarence ordered the materials for the ladder for the \$4,500 roof project. Both of these projects will be paid from the capital campaign fund.

Council members are working with their committee members on program budgets for the October council meeting so we can begin creating a proposed 2022 budget.

Our income for August was \$23,298.79. Our total income for the year to date is \$185,067.76. Our budget percentage of income through August is 86.61%. Our budget year is 66.67%.

Our expenses for August totals \$17,277.43. Our expenses total for the year is \$156,491.03, which is 64.19% of our budget.

The difference of income to expenses for the year shown on the finance reports is \$28,576.73.

Due to conflicts with schedules and the continuing virus situation, we have decided to pursue opportunities closer to home and shorter in duration. DOORSTEP

Doorstep is beginning to plan how we will operate our Christmas Store this year. We will still adopt 260 households with 800+ individuals from the Christmas Bureau as we do every year. How distribution will be handled is being planned, and we will update our member congregations once we know the details.

We are now through the first quarter of our 55th Anniversary year, and donations for the 55th Anniversary Fund to replace our HVAC have brought in over \$31,000 so far. We feel incredibly blessed to have received this amount! We need at least another \$129,000 to replace the HVAC system which is 60+ years old. Anything over the HVAC amount will go to help more of our neighbors in need with basic needs such as rent and utility assistance. We are asking our supporters to donate a minimum of \$55 per person towards our 55th Anniversary Fund...
