

WE'RE A HEALTHY, GROWING CHURCH

Pastor's Corner - Great news! Did you know we were a "healthy, growing church"? You probably knew intuitively. Now, we have the survey evidence to support our hopes! Thanks to the thirty persons who completed the <u>Natural</u> <u>Church Development</u> (NCD) survey! There was a broad segment of active participants who answered ninety questions which NCD processed and sent us the results (see below). The good news: we are healthy and growing, AND we have potential for greater growth in the coming years!

The survey results showed we are an "above average" church compared to bigger and smaller churches in the US. We are strongest in Need Oriented Evangelism - helping people with tangible needs (e.g., food, clothing, counseling) through compassionate programs and making newcomers feel welcome. The church is strong in ministry, spiritual, governance, loving relationships, and worship. In fact, the results confirmed what the Council recently learned: people connect with God and enjoy the worship services so we do not need to make any major changes at this time.

The area we need the greatest amount of work is... Holistic Small Groups and Vision Casting.



Holistic Small Groups is rooted in the belief that "Jesus' followers grow stronger together." We need each other to develop our faith, and joy as we support and encourage one another. The Bible teaches us:

"As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another." Proverbs 27:17

Join me as we work to develop spirituallyoriented communities that multiply disciples, integrate newcomers, by providing a safe place for learning and sharing.

I invite you to learn more about the NCD Survey Results on Saturday, October 30 at 10:00 AM or Thursday, November 4 at 7:00 PM in Holmer Hall or on Zoom. We will talk about the results and ask serious questions about how we can move forward as a stronger, healthier church.

OUR CHURCH FINANCES

Thanks to all who completed the survey from the Long-Range Planning Committee in mid-October. There were 21 items on our **Fortifying our Foundation for the Future** building and grounds wish list. Next steps are to ask everyone to **pray** for our \$300,000 capital campaign and how you can help; **pledge** what you feel you can give now and over the next 3 years; and **praise** God for our church and how He works through us for His glory.

At the October Council meeting a draft 2022 budget was approved. The budget will be presented to you for your approval at our December 5th Stewardship Breakfast.

Our income for September was \$39,394.55. Our total income for the year to date is \$224,462.31. Our budget percentage of income through September is 105.04%. Our budget year is 75.0 %.

Our expenses for September totals \$19,877.34. Our expenses total for the year is \$176,749.19 which is 72.5% of our budget.

The difference of income to expenses for the year shown on the finance reports is \$47,713.12.



Doorstep

We have started early in organizing, arranging, and promoting needed items. Our dedicated volunteers have been going through the basement and pulling out all of the previously donated items that we can use for 2021. But, we will still need more blankets, household items, and games/puzzles.

Doorstep will adopt the 260 households and 800+ individuals from the Christmas Bureau like before. However, this year we are adding to what the families will receive. We will provide our regular Christmas food package, a \$20 gift card for each family member, a health kit, blanket or quilt, a household item such as coffee pot, crockpot, sheet set, school supplies, and a family pack of games, puzzles and toys.

What we need for Christmas at this time is:

Full/Queen and King Blankets (new) Coffee pots, Crockpots, Toasters, Skillet Sets and Electric Skillets (new) Board games and puzzles (new) Monetary Donations

Proceeding with the Christmas Project this way does increase our costs overall with the gift cards (\$16,000) and the regular food order (\$12,000), but it is the safest way to proceed for 2021.


