REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTION (RMD)

In talking about your giving to the church, you have heard me mention RMDs, required minimum distribution. This is an IRS-mandated amount of money that investors starting at age 72 must withdraw every year from their retirement savings accounts, including traditional IRAs, and employer-sponsored 401(k) and 403(b) plans.

There is a tax advantage to you if you wish to make your tithe to the church from your RMD. Your tithe can be transferred directly from your IRA and is not considered federally taxable income for you. It's like getting a deduction

because while the distribution counts towards your RMD, it is not included in your gross income. The key is asking for the amount of the transfer to go directly to West Side Baptist Church and not to you as the "middle man".

You should talk with your financial advisor if you are qualified for an RMD. Let me know if you have any


With great appreciation for their time and work on the Long-Range Planning Committee, I want to thank the committee members: Harry Carpenter, Pastor Ivan Greuter, Tom Mansfield, Clarence Payne and Nathan Poe who worked with me for months planning our <u>Fortifying our Foundation for the Future</u> building and grounds capital campaign. As we begin the new year you will see us begin working on the projects you identified.

The 2022 church program budget will be presented for your approval at our December 5 Stewardship Breakfast. I hope you will plan to join us (see enclosed budget).

Our income for October was \$12,844.00. Our total income for the year to date is \$237,306.31. Our budget percentage of income through October is 111.05%. Our budget year for the first 10 months is 83.3%.

Our expenses for October total \$21,769.09. Our expense total for the year is \$198,268.90 which is 81.33% of our budget. The difference of income to expenses for the year shown on the finance reports is \$30,090.00.

American, African migrants that have made their new home in Tijuana, Mexico. Moise is a business entrepreneur, and Deliris is a pastor and occupational therapist. They have been



DOORSTEP - Our focus the rest of this year is Doorstep's Christmas Project. Earlier in the year we thought we may be able to have the actual Christmas Store... until the Delta variant arrived! So, for the safety of everyone, and the fact that we might not have enough volunteers to pull off the full Christmas Store, we are doing something similar to last year.

We have started early in organizing, arranging, and promoting needed items. Our dedicated volunteers have been going through the basement and pulling out all of the previously donated items that we can use for 2021. But, we will still need more blankets, household items, and games/puzzles.

Doorstep will adopt the 260 households and 800+ individuals from the Christmas Bureau like before. However, this year we are adding to what the families will receive. We will provide our regular Christmas food package, a \$20 gift card for each family member, a health kit, blanket or quilt, a household item such as coffee pot, crockpot, sheet set, school supplies, and a family pack of games, puzzles and toys.

What we need for Christmas at this time is:

Full/Queen and King Blankets (new)

Coffee pots, Crockpots, Toasters, Skillet Sets and Electric Skillets (new)

Board games and puzzles (new)

Monetary Donations

Proceeding with the Christmas Project this way does increase our costs overall with the gift cards (\$16.000) and the regular food order (\$12,000), but it is the safest way to proceed for 2021.




WARM THANK YOU!
