From the Pastor's Desk

A Spiritual Adventure

Where is "Lent" in the Bible? It's not. There are many church words - like Easter, Christmas, Advent, Trinity, etc. - that do not appear in holy scripture, yet Christians still celebrate them. The season of "Lent," for example, comes from the Latin word, *Quadragesima*, meaning "fortieth." There is a Christian spiritual practice of fasting and praying for forty days prior to Easter (not counting Sundays)) to remember Jesus' forty days in the desert where he fasted, prayed, and was tempted (Matthew 4:1-11; Mark.1:12; Luke 4:1-15), and Moses' forty days on Mount Sinai when God gave him the 10 Commandments (Exodus 32). Fasting and prayer are spiritual disciplines. Some Christians chose not to observe Lent because it does not appear in Scripture, but enjoy a *50 Day Spiritual Adventure* (Ash Wednesday to Easter including Sundays) to focus on the Cross in preparations for the joyous events of Easter.

Starting Sunday, March 6, I will start a new sermon series on "At the Cross" - six Sundays focused on the meaning and mystery of Christ's suffering, sacrifice, death, and resurrection. Why the cross? How does it save? The meaning behind each act and symbol. The hope salvation brings to all!



We will also have services during Holy Week to help us experience God's saving grace and faithfulness. Watch for more details. Our partners, Potwin Presbyterian and Westside Christian Church, will be hosting service. You are invited to participate with them.

I hope you can use the time between now and Easter for a spiritual adventure that can strengthen and renew your life in Christ. Let me know if you want or need devotional materials to help you grow in love and faith.

Church Treasurer's Report...

We have a good start to the year with our church finances. Our income for January was \$18,262.80 which is 6.89% of our budget. This includes our annual disbursement of \$8,054 from our investment in the Topeka Community Foundation.

Our expenses for January totaled \$24,657.96 which is 9.56% of our budget. Almost \$5,000 of the expenses was for building maintenance and repairs. Also, just like our home utilities, we paid more than \$2,000 for gas in January.

Our checking account balance is \$96,919.87. The majority of this is two accounts that carried over into the new year – the new Capital Campaign monies totaling \$80,697.07 and Outreach totaling \$11,159.05.

One of the items on our capital campaign project list was completed in January. The baby closet was expanded into the room next to it. I hope you can go downstairs to see the expanded area and to hear about the many families being served by this outreach program.

The Benevolent Fund balance is \$5,411.25.

The Mission Committee has recommended \$200 from the old capital campaign account be given to Jessa Greuter to assist her with her mission trip to Albania. Jessa leaves on May 31st to fly to the country of Albania. She and several others from Ottawa University will be meeting with a missionary who has planted three churches there. They will be painting and doing projects to help maintain the buildings as well as spending time with local college students.


