

HOLY ORDINANCES (SACRED ACTS)

We celebrate two sacred acts ordered by our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ:

- 1. **BELIEVER'S BAPTISM** Believer's Baptism is the immersion of a person in the water regardless of age who receives Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and publicly professes faith to walk the Jesus way. The Council schedules baptisms on Sunday mornings throughout the year. Believers may be baptized in the church baptistry, in the river, a swimming pool, a pond, or a lake. Please get in touch with the Minister if you want to be baptized.
- 2. **THE LORD'S SUPPER** The Lord's Supper or Holy Communion is celebrated on the first Sunday of each month and special occasions. We practice *Open Communion*, which means all persons of faith, regardless of age, race, gender, membership, denominational affiliation, or church tradition, are welcome to partake of the Table of the Lord. In solidarity with our brothers and sisters seeking freedom, we use only non-alcoholic grape juice. Please hold each element until everyone is served; we will feast together. Gluten-free wafers are available upon request.
