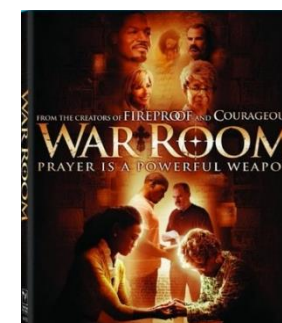

Now she serves in Colombia at the Torch Bible Institute (Instituto Biblico la Antorcha), which focuses on preparing only ethnic leaders and pastors from the 107 tribes spread throughout Colombia to serve among their communities. Walla serves as co-director, academic coordinator, and teacher. She is also a pastoral assessor to the three churches founded in Bogota and participates in some movements and organizations serving ethnic groups and churches. In addition, she receives short-term mission teams.
