


From the Pastor's Desk: "Wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." Ephesians 5:14

Are you an early, happy riser? Do you know anyone who likes to get out of bed in the morning? I enjoy the early mornings when no one else is awake. The house is quiet, calm, and I can get a lot done...if I have gone to sleep at a decent time the previous night. Let's be honest, there are morning persons in our household and there are some (okay, most) who consider anything before eleven o'clock early.

I remember as a child getting my mom to commit to waking up for the Sunrise Service on Easter. She would promise to get up and drive me to the hilltop where we would gather with other Christians to watch the sun rise behind a wooden cross. It was a big deal to me!

My mom was not a morning person. Her rule was "make no noise and do not talk to me until I have had my second pot of coffee and piece of chocolate cake" - no exaggeration or hyperbole. But on Easter morning, she made an exception. It is a precious memory of my mom sacrificing her rest so she could hold my hand at the service.





GETTING TO KNOW OUR CHURCH FRIENDS

Don Johnson has been a member of West Side Baptist Church for more than 47 years. He has served in a number of positions with the church and currently is the Coordinator of Missions.

Don lives northeast of Lawrence so he probably drives the farthest to church on Sundays. It is 65 miles roundtrip. He's married to Sandra and has two daughters, three granddaughters and two grandsons. Several years ago Don appeared on Wheel of Fortune with one of his granddaughters. You'll have to ask him how well they did!

Don grew up one of seven children with a dad who worked as a butcher and a mother who was a

homemaker. At 12 years he joined the Eighth Street Baptist Church in Kansas City, Kansas and that was where he was baptized.

He graduated from Sumner High School in KCK in May 1962 and shortly after graduation he joined the U.S. Air Force. Don served as a Jet Aircraft Mechanic with the 461st Bombardment Wing Strategic Air Command at Amarillo Air Force Base, Texas. He was released from active duty in 1966.

After serving in the service Don came home and decided to go to Kansas City, Kansas Community College and graduated with an Associate Arts degree in May 1969. Then he attended Wichita State University studying engineering and graduated in May 1972 with a BS in Electrical Engineering.

So what did he do with his engineering degree? Don went to work for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company in Topeka as an equipment engineer. I am told that working for Southwestern Bell is where he met and became good friends with long-time West Side Baptist Church member Ed Moody who invited him to church. And we are glad he did because Don joined our church and has been an active member ever since.

Don retired after almost 20 years from Southwestern Bell Telephone (a buy-out when they downsized) in 1991. But quickly after a headhunter from Sprint was at his door asking him to work for them in Kansas City. Don worked at Sprint until officially retiring in 2002.

We can always count on Don. In March he read scriptures for Sunday morning services, he regularly attends Wednesday morning Bible Study, and this year he is once again chairing our Missions Committee.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Our Church Finances

Our income for February was \$18,126.28. This is 13.5% of our budget. 2/12 of the budget year is 16.67%. We have \$270 in the Bruno Sprenks memorial fund. Our youth raised \$922 with their Valentine's luncheon.

Our expenses for February totaled \$20,939.18 which is 15.32% of our budget.

The difference of income to expenses for February is -\$2,812.90.

Our checking account balance shown on the balance sheet is \$128,489.44. A large portion of our balance is in the Capital Campaign and Outreach funds.

The Endeavor investment report was good news to start the year. For January, we had an increase of \$14,325.93. I would guess February's report won't be as good.

The Benevolent Fund balance is \$6,830.17.

At the March council meeting, the council voted to ask the Memorials Committee to discuss underwriting the cost of a new laptop computer for the pastor. The committee will meet and discuss which memorial(s) to recommend.

Your first quarter giving statement will be ready in early April. It will have your pledge for the year on the statement. As always, let me know if you see something that isn't what you expected.

BAPTIST WOMEN'S AMERICAN **INISTRY PROJECT** – Each year, the ABWM of the Central Region selected ANTIOCH BAPTIST SCHOOL in MONROVIA. LIBERIA for this vear's Special Project: a grant of \$30,000.00 which will provide for the construction of the second floor of the building - bringing the building three-fourth completion to of construction!

This is critical to the long-term vision of upgrading the school to include Senior High grades and vocational training classes, thus enhancing its relevance to the local community and the nation. Completion of the construction will serve as leverage and motivation to secure funding for finishes and furnishings for this second floor – desks, chairs, tables, boards, plumbing, etc.

Building Project - International Ministries has partnered with the Liberia Direct Baptist Missionary Conference since 200. We have prioritized this school-building project out of our mutual commitment to the dignity, liberation, and productive citizenship that require a solid educational foundation and nurture. *The public education system and buildings were destroyed in the Liberia Civil War (1980-1999), followed by the Ebola Epidemic (2013-2016) and COVID-19 Pandemic (2020-2023).* The churches sponsor schools to bring education and the Good News of Jesus Christ to children of all ages. Despite the shortage of teachers and funds, the churches have persevered in providing basic education to students.

In the 2021-2022 school year, Antioch Baptist Elementary and Junior High School had 146 students – 69 females and 79 males. They employ 24 teachers and staff – 9 females and 15 males. One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) grants and local resources have resulted in the construction of the ground and first floors of a four-floor school building – providing eight classrooms. This is attracting additional students, creating a need for more space! A good "problem" to have.




