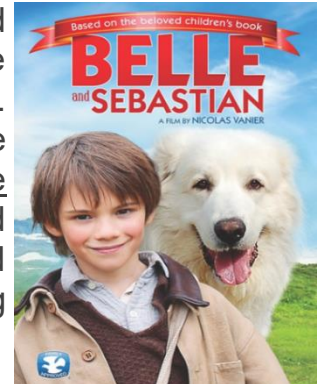
NEWS IN THE PEWS

ABCCR Mission Discover Tour to Liberia, Africa -

The ABCCR Mission Team will visit ministries and projects supported by International Ministries including the ABWMCR project site at Antioch Baptist Church and School in **January 2024**. We will partner with International Ministries to discover God's work in and through our partners, build relationships with sisters and brothers in Christ in Liberia, and visit Providence Baptist Church and other historical sites in the capital of Monrovia. It will be a unique opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of the historic relationship between American Baptists and Liberian Baptists and between Liberia and the United States of America. The trip will likely occur in early January 2024 and be a 10-day experience (including travel) with a September 1, 2023, deadline for commitment to go on the trip. The estimated cost, including airfare, lodging, meals, registration, cultural orientation, in-country transportation, and emergency medical insurance, would be **\$4,000-\$5,000 per person**.
