
PASTOR'S PAGE



TREASURER'S REPORT

Our income for November was \$11,828.62. The total to date for the year is \$235,921.09 and is 88.24% of our budget. 11/12 of the year is 91.67%. The youth fundraiser was a great success with \$660 income in November with an additional \$128 deposited the first week of December.

Our expenses for November were \$30,818.57 for total expenses from first of the year through November of \$273,944.82. This is 99.7% of the budget. Expense items this month to note include: payroll was for 3 pay periods; #7550 Capital Contingency - \$1,250 – DNR Plumbing for the baptistry repair; #7570 Stewardship Program - \$833.88 for Oct. & Nov. expenses for Stewardship luncheon; #8190 Misc Exp Christian Ed - \$294.15 plus \$471.30 from Paslay Education Fund for Parenting Class materials; #8350 NE Area Dues - \$51.50; #8535 CVLI License - \$305.89.

The difference of income to expenses through November is -\$38,023.73 compared to October of -\$18,437.57.

Our checking account balance shown on the balance sheet for November is \$101,096.44 compared to October's balance of \$119,576.90. You will see the general fund is now \$-12,091.84 which is the first time for the year that we are in the red. We are using the other monies in the checking account (Capital Campaign, Outreach Grant and Youth funds and Liberia Mission Trip) to cash flow our monthly budgeted expenses.

The Endeavor Investment report was not received in time to be on the report. We have a \$21,702.65 gain for the month of November.

The Benevolent Fund balance is \$6,079.62.

The 2024 budget was discussed and approved at the December 3rd All-Church Breakfast Meeting. You will receive the approved 2024 budget and year-end financials in the annual report that will be handed out at our annual meeting scheduled for Sunday, February 4th. I hope you will plan to attend.

The Capital Campaign projects continue. After the first of the year we will begin the repairs and painting of the sanctuary ceiling and walls. At that point we will then evaluate what money we have left to complete the remaining projects on our list. As chair of the Long Range Planning Committee, I encourage you to continue your commitment in the third year of our 3-year \$300,000 **Fortifying our Foundation for the Future** Campaign. If you didn't make a pledge but want to help support the building projects, you can do that anytime by indicating on your check, envelope or online gift that it is to support the building projects/capital campaign.

Thanks for your pledge card for 2024. We currently have 31 pledges. Pledge cards are on the table outside the church office and you can turn in your pledge card at any time.




