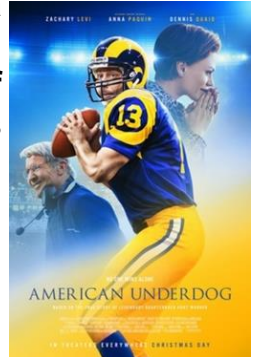
IT'S COMING... GLOBAL MISSION ENCOUNTER 2024 –
