#### FROM PASTOR'S PEN: "TAKE UP YOUR CROSS!"

"Then Jesus said to his disciples,
'If any want to become my followers,
let them deny themselves and
take up their cross and follow me."

Matthew 16:24 (NRSV)



Can You Walk with Me for 40 Days? LENT is a time to walk with Jesus on the road to Calvary, to deepen our understanding of His sacrifice, and to embrace the call He places upon the life of every person called to follow Him: "Take up your cross and follow me."

This Lent, I invite you to join me in a daily devotional journey centered on "The Cross of Christ"—the ultimate symbol of God's love, justice, and grace. As John Stott writes in **The Cross of Christ**, "The cross is the blazing fire at which the flame of our love is kindled, but we have to get near enough for its sparks to fall on us." This season, let us draw close to the cross so that its meaning may transform our hearts and lives.

Each day, I will invite you to set aside time to meditate on a Bible verse, pray, fast, and reflect on Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection. The journey will take four stages (or peaks of a mountain) using

Stott's book as our guide:

- (1) Approaching the Cross,
- (2) Centering on the Heart of the Cross,
- (3) The Achievements of the Cross, and
- (4) Living Under the Cross of Christ.

Consider passages such as Isaiah Philippians 2:5-11, and Galatians 2:20. These verses remind us that Christ's sacrifice was not only for our salvation but also an invitation to live in humble obedience to God.



On Sunday, March 2 (before Ash Wednesday), worshippers will be invited to take up a small cross from Bethlehem for their Lenten journey. This cross is free. You will also be invited to read devotionals, do prayer activities, and listen to a new sermon series on "The Cross of Christ." We'll focus our hearts and minds on Jesus' journey to Calvary - His Work on Calvary - and his Triumph Through the Cross.

Lent is a time of surrender, much like Jesus surrendered His will to the Father. Will you take up your cross this season? Will you walk the path of discipleship with greater faithfulness? The road to Easter morning leads through Good Friday. But in dying to self, we find new life in Christ.

May we journey together, shaped by the power of the cross, until we stand in the light of resurrection hope.

### TREASURER'S REPORT

#### **Our Church Finances**

Our income for the first month of 2025 was \$22,407.77. Our target for each month is 1/12<sup>th</sup> of our budget which is \$30,738.59.

Our expenses for January totaled \$52,691.96 with a target of \$24,220.84. The reason the expenses for our first month of the year were so high was because we had our second half payment of \$20,000 for the elevator repair along with several bills to McElroy's totaling around \$6,000. Not the way we want to start the year but it is what it is.

The difference of income to expenses for January is -\$30,284.19.

Our checking account balance shown on the balance sheet is \$29,672.63. This includes \$6,526.18 in Outreach funds, \$53,977.93 in Capital Campaign, \$602.66 in the Youth Fund and \$1,268.10 in the Benevolent Fund. I also made a \$13,000 transfer of funds from our investment account approved at the January Council meeting to start the year with a zero balance.




