

a peaceful and guiet life, godly and dignified in every way" (1 Tim. 2:1-2, Rom 13:1-7):

- The United States of America: anger and aggressive action caused by outrage
- The President and Executive Branch, Congress, and Courts for the renewal of civic engagement and public discourse in Kansas, especially around issues of community identity, virtue, and civic responsibility.
- State of Kansas, Governor, and Legislature as they respond to the SNAP/food-aid crisis triggered by the federal shutdown—may they have wisdom and resources to protect the most vulnerable.
- County Commissioners, the City of Topeka, the Mayor, and local governments
- Employment, Unemployed, and Underemployed: all people can find meaningful work
- Farmers, Workers, Producers, and Unemployed
- **Federal Employees** Pray for families in our region who may face hardship and financial stress because of lost jobs or unemployment in the federal sector.
- First Responders: Fire & Rescue, Police, Security Officers, Sheriff, State Patrol, etc.
- **MILITARY CHAPLAINS & FAMILIES**: Pray for the faithful in the U.S. military and their families, as the cancellation of religious-support contracts for military chapels poses challenges to spiritual care and freedom of worship for soldiers.
- Military Personnel and National Guard Active Duty and Veterans, Persons Missing in Action, and spouses and families of the deployed.
- **National security & infrastructure** Safety of communication systems, public safety, responsible planning, and protection of vital services.
- **Political and Social polarization** Pray for wisdom, humility, and unity in leadership and citizens, that divisiveness may give way to understanding.
- Poor, Neglected, Exploited, Homeless, Oppressed, and Trafficked:
- Prisons and Correctional Institutions Shawnee Co Correctional Facility and Staff
