

(Stairstep of Giving – Over)

CONSIDER GROWING ONE STEP OR MORE

Consider the "Grow One Step" graph below. By completing an Estimate of Giving Card (see enclosed), you will join the growing number of families who support God's work at West Side Baptist Church! We thank God for the 49 families who gave generously and regularly each week in 2025 – including 10 first-time givers.



Starting from the lower left of the Stairstep of Giving above, you'll notice number 37. This represents the 37 worship attenders or active families out of 86 who have not contributed as "Givers of Record" to the financial support of God's work in the past twelve months — roughly 43.0% of families who call West Side their "home". Our goal this year is to have every person a giver of record, which means we have a record of their giving, whether it's through a check, online donation, or giving envelope. If you would like to become a "giver of record," please contact the Church Office to request giving envelopes, give online, or place your donation in an offering envelope with your name on it.

As you move up the stairs, you will see that there are, on average:

- 7 families are recorded as giving \$0.01 to \$4.99 weekly
- 4 families are recorded as giving \$5.00 to \$9.99 weekly
- 4 families gave \$10.00 to \$20.00 weekly, which equals a meal at a restaurant.
- 1 family gave \$20.00 to \$29.99 weekly.
- 5 families gave \$30.00 to \$39.99 weekly, which equals a golf game.
- 5 families gave \$40.00 to \$49.99 weekly
- 9 families gave \$50.00 to \$74.99 each week, which equals admission costs for a couple to attend one movie, not including the popcorn, soda, and snacks.
 The average member gives \$55.00 per week to God through the church.
- 5 families gave \$75.00 to \$99.99 each week.
- 1 family gave \$100.00 to \$149.00 per week.
- And finally, eight families are the top givers, sharing \$150.00 or more weekly six of these families donate \$10,000.00 –\$ 30,000.00 each year to God through the church.

The Good News: 70% of church families give \$20.00 or more to God each week. Is God calling you to give a portion of your time, talents, and treasures to Him through my local church?
