# ADVENT: PREPARING FOR CHRIST'S SECOND COMING - Second Sunday of Advent (Year A):

- **Isaiah 11:1–10** The shoot from Jesse, the Spirit upon him, the justice and peace of his reign.
- Romans 15:4–13 Encouragement in hope, unity, and endurance; "Welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you."
- Matthew 3:1–12 John's preaching of repentance, warning of unfruitful lives, the coming one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Focus: "Preparing the Way of the Lord" — This week emphasizes John the Baptist's call to repentance, and the prophetic hope of a just ruler from Jesse's line. The tension is between our brokenness and God's promised restoration. We anticipate a King who brings righteousness, peace, and justice.


