FROM PASTOR: "ON YOUR MARK...THE MAY MARATHON"

Are you ready for the May Marathon? It's what I call the fast paced celebrations - some civic, some sacred - crammed together before summer break. Graduations, Mother's Day, Ascension Day, Last Day of School, Memorial Day, Pentecost, and Trinity Sunday. Our worship colors flash from white (Easter) to gold (Ascension), to red (Pentecost), to gold (Trinity), and then green for the summer. These are not random or meaningless activities. The succession of days form a kind of parade - a witness to the movement of God among His people for His glory.

Our Christian tradition has long spoken of the Church in two forms: **the Church Triumphant** and **the Church Militant**. The Church Triumphant is that "great cloud of witnesses" (Hebrews 12:1)—those who have finished their race and now rejoice in God's presence. The Church Militant is us—the living Church on earth—still running the long race of faith, still engaged in the struggle of the gospel, and still serving in God's mission.

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses... let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us." (Heb. 12:1)

But don't let all of the activities get you down. If you are going to make it safely to summer recess, you'll need to pace yourself, and be an encourager to others as we make sure everyone is a winner in the race of faith:

- ◆ **On Mother's Day**, we will give thanks for all women who nurtured faith in us—many of whom now belong to that great cloud of witnesses. Their prayers, sacrifices, and testimonies continue to surround us, encouraging us to keep running with perseverance.

- ◆ **On Memorial Day**, we remember those who gave their lives in service to our nation. While this is a civic observance, it echoes the deeper Christian truth that sacrifice is never forgotten in the economy of God. We honor their memory, and we look beyond the grave with resurrection hope.
- ◆ **We will celebrate the often overlooked Ascension Sunday.** The risen Christ is not absent, but reigning. He has gone before us, not only as Savior but as the One who has completed the race and now intercedes for us. From his place of authority, he calls us onward.
- ◆ **We then celebrate Pentecost**, when the Holy Spirit empowers the Church to run this race faithfully. We do not run alone. The Spirit strengthens us, guides us, and keeps us moving forward when the path is steep and the race is long.
- ◆ **And don't forget Trinity Sunday**, when the church celebrates a foundational doctrine: **The Trinity** (One God in Three: Father, Son and Holy Spirit). This begins our long journey into "Ordinary Time" (June to October). But we know, **there is nothing ordinary about Ordinary Time**. We will be focusing on relational and spiritual growth.

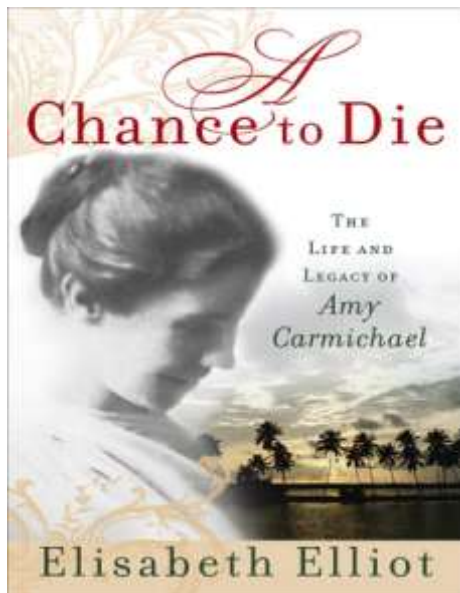

TREASURER'S REPORT

Our Church Finances

Our income through the first quarter of the year (through March) is \$147,211.29 which is 50.99% of our \$288,680 budget (without the budgeted investment income of \$33,187 for building maintenance). This is an increase from the \$116,427.26 through February.

Our expenses through March totaled \$102,356.84 which is 26.72% of our budget. This is an increase from the \$84,725.82 through February.

The difference of income to expenses for the year through March is \$44,854.45.

Our checking account balance shown on the balance sheet is \$18,881.42.

We continue making adjustments to our financial record keeping as we change into our new system. You will see a few additional changes over the coming months with more detail on our gifts and expenditures.

The first quarter giving statements have been distributed. If you did not receive yours, please let the church office or me know. This statement should contain your 2026 giving pledge. Please review to make sure it is recorded correctly.

MISSION

Eight West Side Baptist Church members (Betty and Mark Arnold; Pat Carpenter, Nancy Lindberg, Marty and Jay Stevenson, and Patty and Josh Tripod) recently braved early morning and late night travel to experience a most rewarding week of service at Rainbow Acres in Camp Verde, AZ. A big thank you goes to Tonya and Brian Widow for delivering us to the airport and picking us up from the train station, both before 5 AM.



What a wonderful place Rainbow Acres is! The 50 acre ranch offers adults with developmental disabilities the chance to reach their potential in a safe and supportive environment. We were so impressed with the activities and classes in life and job skills, animal science and horticulture, art and music therapy, and practical and fine arts. The atmosphere here is truly welcoming and loving.

Our team was honored to lead daily devotions and prayer circles which were optional for ranchers, but well attended. The ranchers were eager to participate and pray. We were amazed by their Bible knowledge, faith, and community.



We were delighted to host eight ranchers and a caregiver on a field trip to “Out of Africa”, an animal refuge and safari park nearby. We enjoyed all the opportunities of the park and a relaxed time getting to know the ranchers.



We worked diligently on three projects for the ranch. Mark and Nancy painted stripes in the parking lot of their community building. Josh and Jay shoveled and moved pea gravel that needed replacing. Pat, Marty, Patty, and Betty cleared brush and weeded the orchard. Though we all endured a few sore muscles, we were quite pleased with what we accomplished.

Another highlight for the ranchers was our afternoon of Bingo. We gave out all the prizes and made sure that each rancher won at least once. The next afternoon we hosted a card making session so that ranchers could make Mother's Day and various greeting cards for family and friends.

We enjoyed lunches together with all the ranchers in the community center, but in the evenings we paired up and went to different homes for dinner. We went back to the same homes each evening and so became better acquainted with some of the ranchers.

At the last lunch our team delivered a love gift of \$1000 from our generous members here at home. All the ranchers and staff asked if we would come back. When we filled out our volunteer evaluation, they even asked for our return date!

There were many firsts for members of our mission team: first time at the Grand Canyon, first time leading prayers and devotions for a large group, first time zip lining, first time kissing a giraffe, first time to drive and dump a tractor, first time to ride the train. The only disappointment was that Pastor Ivan was unable to go with us. We have been blessed with an experience we will never forget. Thanks be to God and His church for sending us.

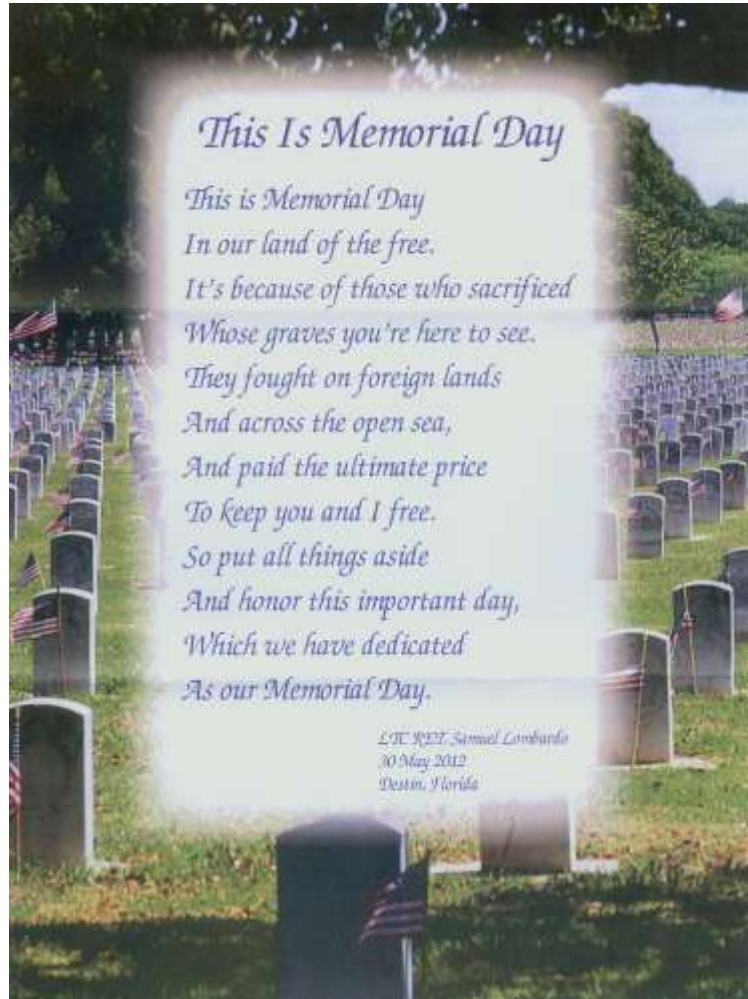
